IN MEMORIAM CHARLES CARROLL

We regret to announce that Brother Charles Carroll, 32° KCCH, passed away on September 3, 2018.

Charles was born June 22, 1925, in Minneapolis, MN. He enlisted in the Marine Corp at age 17 and served in the Pacific during World War II. In 1948 he married Garnet Morey, his bride of 70 years. They have twin daughters, Teri and Nancy.

The family moved to Ventura in 1953. Given his experiences in WWII, Charles wanted to serve others in their greatest time of need, after the loss of a loved one, which led him to open and operate five mortuaries in Ventura County, one of which still bears his name. He also served on the Ventura City Council from 1961 to 1965, and was a member of the Ventura Downtown Lion's Club.




Charles was a member of Poinsettia Lodge #633 (later Channel Islands Lodge #214). He joined Santa Barbara Scottish Rite in 1960, then affiliated with the Valley of Ventura in 1978 as a charter member. In our Valley he was especially active in stagecraft, heading up the make-up department for many years and helping with wardrobe. He was designated a Knight Commander of the Court of Honour in 2001.


Charles was loved and respected by all who knew him and we will miss him.


IN MEMORIAM EMILIO BONERGES REYNOSO

We regret to announce that Brother Emilio Reynoso, 32° KCCH, passed away on September 25, 2018.

Emilio was born on June 30, 1924, in the Philippines. He was one of the first Filipinos to join the U.S. Navy just as WWII was ending. He was aboard the USS Wisconsin on its first cruise after it was built. He served in the Navy for over 20 years, retiring in 1965 as a Senior Chief Disbursing Clerk. He then served in the U.S. Civil Service from 1966 to 1986. He was a charter member of the Fleet Reserve Organization at El Centro, CA. He also served in many other civic organizations.







Emilio was especially active in the York Rite bodies, being a member of, and receiving honors in, numerous organizations. These include serving as High Priest of Oxnard Chapter Royal Arch Masons, as Illustrious Master of Ventura Council of Royal and Select Masters, as Eminent Commander of Ventura Commandry Knights Templar, as Sovereign Master of Channel Coast Council of Allied Masonic Degrees, as Pre-Eminent Governor of Saint Albans York Right College, and as the first President of Channel Islands York Rite Association. He was also knighted a Knight of the York Cross of Honour. He served in more roles, and received more other honors, than we are able to list.

He also served as President of the Oxnard Shrine Club, as Puissant Sovereign of the Red Cross of Constantine, Pacifica Conclave, as President of the Ventura County Chapter, National Sojourners, Inc., and as Camp Commander of West Point Camp, Heroes of 76.

Emilio was a tireless worker and a friend to all, and all of us will miss seeing him and his lady Sally at our events.

So Brothers, let's work for tomorrow, And read from a braver man's tome. May fraternity e'er be our focus, No matter what Lodge we call home.




